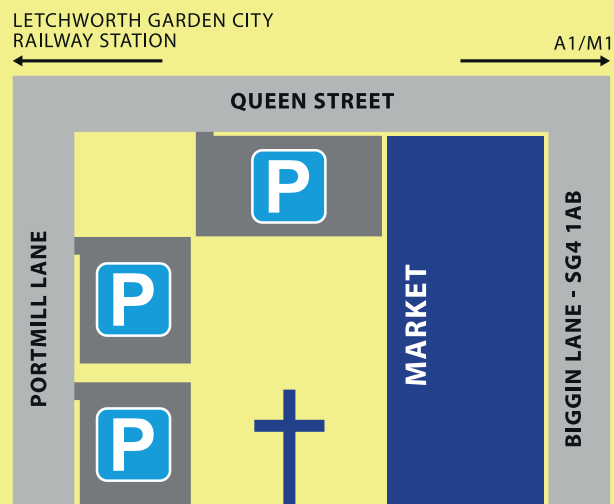

PLACES TO VISIT IN HITCHIN

St. Marys Church - SG5 1HP

Founded in 792 and listed as a 'Minster' in the Domesday book, suggesting royal patronage. The tower is open occasionally throughout the year giving an unrivalled view of Hitchin.

British Schools Museum - SG4 9TS

Founded in 1810 which includes the only surviving Lancasterian Hall designed for the famous Monitorial System.

Hitchin Lavender - SG5 3UA

Keeping the tradition of lavender farming in Hitchin which dates from 1586. Hitchin Lavender has around 25 miles of lavender rows which you can walk through and pick your own flowers.

N.Hertfordshire Museum - SG5 1JE

Covering North Hertfordshire, the museum deals with the history of the district.

Hitchin has a varied history and is filled with many fine buildings of architectural interest dating back to the 1300's which house fine restaurants, shops, pubs and facilities all adding to a unique visitor experience.
